WATER SAFETY INSTRUCTOR COURSE

This course will certify people to be an American Red Cross swim instructor, encompassing both safety and skills to educate those wishing to learn or advance their swimming. This course allows those who pass to teach parent and child aquatics, preschool aquatics, learn-to-swim, safety courses, and water presentations. Participants wanting to register must pass pre-test prior to registering. Please contact (954) 828-5211 for more information.

Prerequisites: Participants must be at least 16 years of age and able to swim 25 yards of the following: front crawl, backstroke, breaststroke, elementary backstroke, and sidestroke. Participants must also be able to swim at least 15 yards of Butterfly, float on back for one minute in deep water, and tread water for one minute.
